INVITATION

You are cordially invited to participate in the Second International Workshop & Summer School on Plasma Physics at Black Sea from Monday, 3rd to Sunday, 9th July 2006.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Workshop & Summer School will serve four purposes:

- Bringing together scientists from the various branches of plasma physics and applications to ensure an interdisciplinary exchange of views and enhance possible collaborations.
- To provide a unique opportunity to scientists from Eastern and Balkan countries, which live in a less favorable for research environment, to communicate with colleagues from the Western countries and USA where substantial development in plasma physics occurs. The final goal is to create links for the needed collaboration between the two societies.
- To open new channels to young talented scientist, from the Eastern and Balkan countries to move and work with the major groups in European Union, which are urgently seeking additional collaborators.
- To stimulate creation of a new generation of young physicists for further development of the above basic topics in fundamental science and applications.

SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM

The workshop will cover wide aspects of low and high temperature plasma concerning the following topics:

- Fusion Plasma
- Plasma Modeling and Fundamentals
- Plasma Sources, Diagnostics and Technology

Invited speakers will give 45 minutes key lectures. There will be also contributed talks (20 min + 5 min questions) and posters.

The official language of the Workshop and the Summer School is English.
